c) Angel, aged 15 entered into a contract with Jie Min Berhad. recently for the purchase of an Ipad for use in her studies. Explain with reasons whether the contract between Angel and Jie Min Berhad. is valid, void or voidable. (6 marks)

d) Ali offered to hire Abu's cow. Abu accepted his offer. Unknown to both of them, the cow was dead at the time of contract. Discuss whether there is a valid agreement between Ali and Abu. (6 marks)
